5th Anniversary of the Solinsky Center for Cancer Care

Celebrating Five Years of Hope and Compassion at The Solinsky Center for Cancer Care at The Elliot

This year marks a significant milestone as we honor the opening of The Solinsky Center for Cancer Care at The Elliot. Over the past 5 years, the Center has become a place of hope, innovation, and compassionate support for patients and their families on their cancer journey.

Since opening in 2020, during the COVID-19 pandemic, the Center has seen 2,780 new cancer diagnoses in medical oncology and has started 4,487 new patients in radiation oncology. To accommodate patient need, two additional nurse navigators were brought on board, bringing the total to four. The number of treatments provided to patients has steadily increased from 22,047 in 2021 to 26,934 in 2024.



Since opening in 2020, philanthropy has helped to provide the following:

- transportation to and from treatment for 3,767 patients.
- nutritional support for 263 patients through the food pantry.
- education and support for 239 cancer survivors.
- expansion of patient programs. The Solinsky Center now offers over 39 programs for patients, including art classes at The Currier Museum, a book club, educational programs, and more.


