Garden Party

On Thursday, May 18, 2023, The Mary & John Elliot Charitable Foundation welcomed guests to the Annual Garden Party at Labelle Winery in Amherst. The event raised just over \$38,000 to help support The Outpatient Elliot Rehabilitation Department. During the event, we were able to hear from George, an Elliot patient, who has experienced first-hand the remarkable care provided by The Elliot Rehabilitation team during his journey of being able to walk again. Funds raised at the Garden Party helped to purchase a Ceiling Mounted Supported Ambulation Unit, which allows patients more flexibility and independence in their rehabilitation.

Walk for Hope

On June 11, 2023, over 500 people gathered for the 5th Annual Walk for Hope at our new location, Southern New Hampshire University raising over \$60,000 for the Solinsky Center for Cancer Care. Funds raised support various services and programs at the Cancer Center including lunch services for patients in treatment for several hours at a time, a food pantry, rideshare services and gas gift cards, mental health bundles, and art therapy programs to all those who walked or donated. Grateful Patient Spotlight

In late March, Robert Sanzo began his cancer treatment journey to treat Stage 1 prostate cancer at The Solinsky Center for Cancer Care at The Elliot.

"I had a great deal of doubt, anxiety, and concern as to the impact of my treatments," says Robert. "However, from the first day of arrival my concerns were comforted by the friendly and compassionate care of the entire staff from reception, to the radiation team, and of course my doctor and the wonderful nursing staff."

Robert completed his treatment on May 9, 2023 and his prostatespecific antigen (PSA) is now at zero. PSA tests are used primarily to screen for prostate cancer. PSA is a protein produced by both cancerous and noncancerous tissue in the prostate.

Robert credits the Cancer Center team for their compassionate and outstanding care. "My heartfelt thanks go out to each and every one of them. They are a gold star team of outstanding clinicians and staff."
