Elliot Medication Management Clinics Our Anticoagulation Clinic will help you and your physician, manage your therapy successfully!

We work one-on-one with you to monitor and counsel you for the duration of your anticoagulant therapy.

At the time of your appointment, a registered nurse performs a **finger stick test**, reviews your results with you and adjusts your dose appropriately. Your results are then updated to your electronic medical record where your physician can review them at any time.

This referral-based program monitors your prothrombin time (PT, INR) so that you will achieve and maintain desired therapeutic levels.



Our Anticoagulation Clinic is conveniently located at the Elliot Senior Health Center, 138 Webster Street in Manchester just minutes away by vehicle from Elliot Hospital's main campus:

- From Points North: From I-93 South take Exit 9S (South) towards Manchester. Merge onto Daniel Webster Highway/Hooksett Road, and stay straight for about 1 mile. Stay right at the intersection (traffic lights) of Beech and Webster Streets. The Senior Health Center will be on the left side of the road, next to Dunkin' Donuts.
- From Points South: From The Everett Turnpike, take Exit 6 towards the Amoskeag Bridge and take a slight right. Cross over Amoskeag Bridge, and at the next of lights take a left onto Elm Street and stay on for 1/4 of a mile. Take a right onto Webster Street and continue to 138. The Senior Health Center is on the left, and is next to Dunkin' Donuts.
- From Downtown Manchester: From Elm Street, take Webster Street to the intersection of Beech and Webster Streets and Hooksett Road. The Senior Health Center is located on the left, next to Dunkin' Donuts.
