The Bernice and Irving Singer Emergency Department Opens Its Doors





On June 13, 2023, the new Bernice and Irving Emergency Department (ED) at The Elliot opened to patients. The \$23.5 million dollar expansion, spanning 22,000 ft., is an extension of the existing Emergency Department and allows for a clinically superior patient experience with enhanced privacy and improved operational flow for staff and patients. The new center was named thanks to the generous support of Robert Singer, in honor of his parents' devotion to the greater Manchester area and improving the lives of others.

Chief Operating Officer Tate Curti stated, "Here in this very space, lives will be saved, injuries will be healed, and hope will be restored."

The Elliot's ED is the busiest in New Hampshire and the southern New Hampshire region's only ACS Level II Trauma Center. The ED is currently averaging more than 55,000 patients per year. The new space will be able to handle more than 65,000 patients annually, with the net gain of about a dozen exam rooms. More than 75% of The Elliot's admissions come through the Emergency Department.

The renovation offers 28 new private exam rooms, for a total of 32 private exam rooms, increasing privacy for a more comfortable, healing environment. The new rooms allow patients double the space in their individual ED room and includes features such as bedside ultrasound machines. The renovation also includes three new state-of-the-art trauma rooms, providing cutting-edge technology for superior trauma care, and advancing our ability to treat critical and life-threatening injuries.

Some other new features include:

- An expanded rapid triage and treatment area to evaluate and quickly respond to patient needs.
- Nine new dedicated bays and three new triage rooms.
- Rooms include advanced infection control with state-of-the-art negative pressure rooms and HVAC technology.
- Modifications allow providers to help better isolate infectious patients, increase ventilation and air filtration systems, and provide additional oxygen ports to care for more patients.

"With this expansion, the Elliot Hospital is poised to meet the growing demands of our community, providing expedited, high-quality emergency care when it's needed most," says Mayor Joyce Craig (now former mayor).

Hybrid Operating Room Advancing Surgical Services at The Elliot

In 2023, The Elliot completed construction and installation of a hybrid operating room (OR). A hybrid operating room is a surgical theater that is equipped with advanced medical imaging devices such as fixed c-arms and CT scanners. These devices allow for safer surgical approaches with better visualization, as well as an expansion of the services and procedures we can provide.

"We are proud to bring the latest surgical technology to our community. As the needs of our patients evolve and grow, we are prepared to meet the variety of complex needs that come our way," said Elliot Health System Vice President of Surgical Services, Beverly Primeau. "This new technology paired with the skill and expertise of our compassionate team of surgeons gives our community the very best in timely surgical care."

A hybrid operating room has become the standard of care for many vascular, thoracic, and acute care procedures, as well as being flexible enough to utilize for other surgical specialties.

The first surgery in the new hybrid OR was a vascular procedure completed by Elliot Medical Director of Vascular Surgery, Chelsey Lewis, M.D. "The addition of a hybrid operating room to The Elliot was essential. Hybrid operating rooms minimize operative times, optimize procedural success rates, and improve patient safety and experience," says Dr. Lewis. "A hybrid room not only significantly improves the quality of many surgeries we already do here at The Elliot, but as technology evolves, allows us to continue to stay relevant in the care that we are able to offer in the future."











The Elliot Young Professionals Group (EYP) is committed to building a community for young professionals in the greater Manchester area who share a common mission to support health and wellness. In addition to providing healthcare resources for young professionals, EYP also provides opportunities for networking and leadership skills. In March, EYP members enjoyed a fun night of networking at the Manchester Country Club, raising over \$1,500 for The Elliot Trauma Program. Other events included a networking night this past October at Vine 32 Wine & Graze Bar. This networking event highlighted The Elliot's Comfort Pets Project, a part of our Dementia Friendly Initiative to create a more comfortable environment for patients with Dementia during their hospital stay.

Federal Grants Totaling over \$5 Million Helping The Elliot Make An Impact on Substance Use Disorder and Workforce Development



Elliot Health System was awarded \$2.25 Million from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services to expand access to medication-assisted treatment for substance use disorder.

The grant provides \$2.25 million over three years to support lasting recovery for people from our community. The project includes collaboration with Makin It Happen Coalition for Resilient Youth, Hillsborough County Superior Court North, Hillsborough County Department of Corrections, and New Hampshire Department of Corrections.

"The need is significant in Manchester to help individuals who are facing substance use disorder and are involved with the justice system or at risk of being incarcerated. This grant will greatly expand availability of medication-assisted treatment, right when it's needed, to give individuals a better chance at living a healthy, fulfilling life," said Elliot Hospital Substance Use Services Department Strategic Consultant Carol Furlong, LCMHC, MAC, MBA."

This past year, The Elliot was also the recipient of a \$3 million grant to expand the nursing program. The grant will be allocated as part of the Department of Labor's Nursing Expansion Grant Program, which is designed to support nursing training programs to diversify the pipeline of nursing professionals and improve the nation's healthcare system, with an emphasis on training people from historically marginalized and underrepresented populations to bring greater employment equity in underserved communities and improve healthcare workforce diversity.

"As workforce shortages continue to impact our health care systems in New Hampshire and across the nation, I'm thrilled to see \$3 million in federal funding headed to our state to support increased medical training opportunities and expand the nursing program at Manchester's Elliot Hospital," said Senator Shaheen, a senior member of the Senate Appropriations Committee. "Strengthening nursing training programs is a crucial step to help close gaps in New Hampshire's health care workforce that we still haven't recovered from in the aftermath of the COVID pandemic. These resources are an important investment in ensuring Granite Staters have reliable access to comprehensive care when they need it most."

The Elliot Hospital Associates 2023 Year in Review

The Elliot Hospital Associates had another busy year raising over \$101,000 for The Elliot and volunteering their time in a variety of ways! The Associates are led by President, Eva Martel who has been a part of the Associates for 8 years. Currently, there are 280 members of the Elliot Associates, with 15 new members joining in 2023. Members volunteer with the Elliot in many capacities – working in the gift shop, singing with the Voluntaires, baking for fundraising sales, sewing activity quilts for our Dementia Friendly Initiative, knitting for the nursery, as well as numerous activities to help fulfill the mission of the Associates.

This year, the Associates have committed to a \$300,000 pledge to The Elliot with \$150,000 earmarked for the new/upgraded Emergency Department and \$150,000 designated for the Elliot's Hybrid Operating Room. Some of their fundraising efforts include their annual calendar raffle, wooden toy airplane raffle, raffle baskets, See Candy sales, and the popular Triva Night event! Did you know that the Associates have raised nearly \$5.6 Million dating back to our database date of 1982.

Trivia Night

The Associates once again hosted their Trivia Challenge event in October at a new venue, The Puritan Conference Center. The sold out event was once again a fantastic night of fun with 188 people testing their trivia skills including many of The Elliot Senior Leadership team, physicians, and staff. The event raised \$16,897 for The Elliot Emergency Department. Join us at the event next year on October 10, 2024.

Pearl Manor Fund Grants over \$350,000 to Area Senior Services Organizations

On behalf of the Pearl Manor Fund Advisory Committee and the Mary & John Elliot Charitable Foundation, we are very pleased to have awarded seven grants for the 2023-2024 grant year.

The committee received nearly \$507,000 in grant requests this year. With no more than \$350,766 available to award, it was a very competitive process with many very worthy projects and programs to consider. The need this year continues to grow, with the increased burden of economic issues, especially for our senior community members and growing concerns around key social determinants of health.

The Pearl Manor Fund is distributed through grants for the specific purpose of providing assistance, comfort, care and treatment for the elder population to include, but not limited to, the needs surrounding medical care, safe housing, nutrition, independent living and transportation assistance.

The Pearl Manor Fund supports the efforts that benefit the elder residents of the Greater Manchester area. The area includes the towns of Allenstown, Auburn, Bedford, Candia, Deerfield, Dunbarton, Goffstown, Hooksett, Manchester, and New Boston.

Delta Dental/ Elliot Corporate 5K Road Race

An estimated 3,600 walkers and runners participated in this year's Delta Dental/Elliot Corporate 5K on August 10th. In its 30th year, the race is the largest road race in New Hampshire, and one of the largest 5K road races in New England! We are excited to be newly partnering with Delta Dental beginning this year!

The event raised over \$16,000 for patient programs at the Solinsky Center for Cancer Care at The Elliot. The Elliot Team raised the 4th highest total for all fundraising teams. The Elliot represented well, with the ladies team coming in 1st place out of 58 corporate teams and the men's team coming in 5th place!





Jennifer Dolloff, a Social Worker for Ambulatory Care Coordination at The Elliot, started her running journey 7 years ago participating in The Delta Dental/ Elliot Corporate 5k Road Race. At the time, she did not consider herself a runner and could not run a mile but was determined to run the race. She was inspired by all the patients she works with every day. Since then, Jennifer has found a love of running. During April 2022, during COVID-19, Jennifer ran 56 miles from her home in Newmarket, New Hampshire, all the way to The Elliot Hospital and back, in honor of all the healthcare workers. She plans to continue running and has hopes of running 100 miles soon!

Supporting Young Patients Through Elliot's Child Life Program





The Child Life Program at The Elliot Hospital focuses on family-centered care with individualized opportunities for developmentally appropriate education, preparation, coping, and play. Our Child Life Specialists help families in many ways during their hospital visits. Child Life Certified Specialist Samantha Anderson, BS, CCLS states, "Being a Child Life Specialist is a rewarding career. Each day in this role, we are able to help children and families cope with being in the hospital and help make their experience more positive. Whether we are preparing a child for what to expect for a surgery or a procedure, helping a child understand their loved one's new diagnosis or their own, or bringing opportunities for play back into the hospital setting – our team feels like we are able to make an impactful difference during medical experiences."

Thanks to the support of donors, the Elliot Child Life team is able to continue to offer new supports and resources. This past June, Samantha attended the Annual Child Life Conference in Dallas, Texas for the first time.

"I was able to attend this year and immersed myself in learning about all of the new resources, evidence-based practices, and various strategies from other Child Life Specialists across the world," says Sammy. "It was a dream come true to be among some of the best Child Life Specialists, learning and growing in my practice, and being able to bring this new information back to our program at the Elliot."

The Child Life Team have also started a new legacy-building offering for families called the Finn's Legacy Heartbeat Project. Child Life Specialists work collaboratively with The Elliot Music Therapist to record a loved one's heartbeat overlaid with a song that is special to the family. "We give this recording to the family and can offer to place the heartbeat inside of a special heartbeat teddy bear as well. Oftentimes, families who receive this resource have a loved one who is chronically ill or nearing end-of-life. Our team works closely with these families to offer bereavement support, age-appropriate education for their children, and often provides age-appropriate books regarding the loved one's diagnosis and/or the loss of a loved one, to help the children in their life cope."

CELEBRATING MILESTONES THROUGH INSPIRED GIVING

Renee and Cam Geddes celebrated their daughter Mila's first birthday with a party fit for a princess! Wanting to pay it forward and give back to The Elliot Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU), they requested that in lieu of gifts, donations be made in Mila's name to the NICU and raised over \$2,000 for the department that they credit with saving her life.

Mila was born at The Elliot Hospital on November 26, 2022, following a very long and difficult delivery. She was immediately admitted to the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit and placed on a cooling blanket. Her father Cam remarks, "For the next seven days she received world-class care from the most incredible team of Doctors and Nurses who ultimately saved her life and gave her a second chance at a successful future."

Today, Mila is thriving. She is a happy, healthy, strong, bright little baby who without the care of the NICU team, would not be where she is today.





"Although we were fortunate enough to only spend seven nights in the NICU, we experienced first-hand the overwhelming challenge that is having your baby admitted to this department and witnessed the same for other parents. We understand the constant struggle of watching your baby lay in a tiny hospital bed, listening to the sounds of foreign machines while you helplessly watch." says Renee.

As they celebrate their daughter's birthday, Cam and Renee continue to look back with gratitude for the care they received at The Elliot NICU, "We are so blessed that our story with Mila had a bright ending, and as a result, wanted to give back to the NICU team. Our hope is that this contribution will provide not only the department and the babies with additional resources, but also the families with current and future babies of the NICU."

Silver Linings

On her 39th birthday last December, Kelly felt a lump in her right breast before a yoga class. There was no lump on the left side. Concerned, she contacted her primary care provider and was in the following Monday for a physical exam; Friday for a mammogram and ultrasound, and days later, an ultrasound biopsy. In a matter of 14 days, Kelly found a lump and was diagnosed with Stage I, Triple Negative Breast Cancer. The diagnosis was terrifying and came as an absolute shock. Kelly was devastated to learn that she would have to undergo chemotherapy to treat this disease. Despite the odds, Kelly used Paxman scalp cooling therapy offered at Elliot Hospital's Solinsky Center for Cancer Care during her eight chemo treatments – 4 adriamycin cytoxan, and 4 taxol (AC-T). Though she lost quite a bit of hair, the scalp cooling worked. She was able to work, to teach yoga, and to go out in public and not worry about the stigma of being a bald cancer patient.

The Silver Linings Project formed serendipitously when Kelly decided to make the one-year anniversary of her diagnosis not a sad one, but a happy one. She and her fabulous community raised over \$5,000.00 with the specific intent to help cancer patients, who might not have funds readily available, obtain a cold cap. The Silver Linings Project is also working closely with The Solinsky Center and the Mary and John Elliot Charitable Foundation to bring awareness to solid-tumor chemo patients about the benefits of cold cap therapy, in addition to facilitating the process of obtaining the cold cap before treatment begins.







Granite State Plumbing Helps Supports The Elliot's Dementia-Friendly Initiative

The Elliot Dementia-Friendly Initiative is committed to making patients living with dementia feel safe and comfortable during their hospital stay. Each floor is equipped with dementia care carts that nurses are trained to use. Each cart has items specific to the patient's needs, including stuffed animals, fidgets, coloring books, puzzles, and more. The realistic stuffed comfort pets can give patients positive feelings and security, when in the hospital, in unfamiliar surroundings.

Team members from Granite State Plumbing and Heating LLC joined Nikki Beauregard and Karen Vaughn (representing our care teams supporting patients with dementia and Alzheimer's disease) and the foundation staff to learn more about the dementia care carts and stuffed animal support program. Granite State Plumbing and Heating has helped to fund the dementia care work for several years, including the purchase of iPads used with patients.

Volunteer Spotlight

Jackie Bessette, Elliot Breast Health Volunteer

Jackie Bessette embodies the definition of selflessness when it comes to giving back to her community. As she puts it, "It's not about us but about what we can do for others." Since November 2014, Jackie has been handcrafting bags from her home for each new breast cancer patient that walks through The Elliot Breast Health Center. She began making these bags when she heard her friend's daughter had breast cancer and received her care at The Elliot. Since 2014, Jackie has made 810 bags for the center, totaling 2,430 hours, roughly 102 days of bag making. She refers to making the bags as a "labor of love" that brings her so much joy. Each bag is handmade with different fabrics and buttons. Attached to each bag, she includes a quote of "What Cancer Cannot Do" to provide inspiration and empowerment to patients. Due to Jackie's talent and love, each new breast cancer patient can leave with a bag filled with different breast cancer resources and support to reference.

Sue Nicholls, Clinical Nurse Manager at The Elliot Breast Health Center, remarks, "Many patients often come back with their bag each visit, using it throughout their breast cancer journey. Each bag given to patients is thoughtfully chosen based on their personality and interests."

While for the first seven years, Jackie bought every fabric and button herself, the past couple years she has received many fabric donations and money from individuals to help make the bags due to people seeing the impact her work has on patients. She makes sure none of the fabric goes to waste! Any fabric she cannot repurpose she brings to her neighbor next door to use for dog beds she crafts for the local animal shelter. Jackie's bags matter to these patients. She reiterates how she feels so blessed that she can make such a difference in their lives with her talent. She plans to continue making bags for as long as she can and hopes her story can inspire others to use their talent for the greater good to help others.





Bouquets of Hope Event

This October, in honor of Breast Cancer Awareness Month, The Mary & John Elliot Charitable Foundation hosted the Bouquets for Hope event, with all funds raised supporting The Elliot Breast Health Center. Guests made their own flower arrangements with instruction from Amelia Ihlo, Rooted Farmers founder, who also discussed her journey in running her own business. Dr. Lana Shikhman and Dr. Marina Feldman, from Elliot Breast Health, also spoke on the importance of cancer screenings and early detection.

Patient Story-Paula Margenau



Amidst the Covid pandemic, Paula Margenau discovered a concerning lump in her breast, no larger than a pencil tip. Initially brushed off by her primary care provider, Paula persisted when she felt the lump growing. Despite continued reassurances, Paula's determination led her to insist on an ultrasound, refusing to leave the office until it was scheduled. Her unwavering resolve saved her life.

Following a series of appointments and examinations, Paula chose to leave the practice she was working with and begin care at the Elliot Breast Health Center with Dr. Lana Shikhman. Dr. Shikhman's expertise and dedication to Paula's case were evident from the start, and Paula

felt an immediate connection. The doctor's words, "It's very bad, but I can fix it," though shocking, instilled confidence and hope.

The subsequent biopsy confirmed Paula's diagnosis of Stage 2B ductal carcinoma with lymph node involvement. Soon after, Paula underwent a partial mastectomy with multiple lymph nodes removed, marking the beginning of her arduous journey. After a follow-up surgery, Paula underwent six months of chemotherapy at The Solinsky Center for Cancer Care at The Elliot, followed by two months of radiation.

Looking back, Paula expresses gratitude for her cancer care providers. "Dr. Shikhman is wonderful. She's such a strong, confident woman. She explained everything and always took the time to sit with us. Her nurse Bethany is also amazing. They gave as much time as we needed to ask questions, cry, complain, or tell them the good things. I would recommend them to anyone." Dr. Josy Matthew, Paula's oncologist, also provided expert care and a reassuring presence throughout her journey.

Paula credits her support system and ability to continue working with much of her success during her journey. Her husband, Keith, was her unwavering pillar of support, attending every appointment and chemo session. In a testament to her resilience, Paula continued to work remotely at Gateways Community Services.

Dr. Shikhman considers Paula an inspiration, explaining "Paula is an amazing spirit and her resilience and kind demeanor in the face of adversity is inspiring and commendable. It was such a privilege and honor to be and remain her ally in her cancer journey. I am always grateful to be chosen and trusted with breast cancer care of patients like Paula."

Paula's story is one of courage, determination, and unwavering support from her medical team, loved ones, and workplace. She is certainly an inspiration to all who have the privilege of hearing her story. As Paula says, "Appreciate every minute because you never know when a doctor is going to come in and say, 'It is bad'".

Garden Party
