

Criteria for Moderate Sedation (Sedation and Analgesia for Non-Anesthesiologists)

Medical Staff members must complete the following steps prior to initial privileging or renewal of privileges not to exceed every three years.

- 1) Review the Elliot Hospital policy "[Sedation/Analgesia, and Anxiolysis by Non-Anesthesiologists, Adult and Pediatric](#)". (This policy is only available for internal Elliot viewing. If external, please contact the Medical Staff Services Department at Credentialing@Elliot-HS.org for a copy.)
- 2) View the ADULT PROCEDURAL SEDATION **and/or** the PEDIATRIC PROCEDURAL SEDATION PowerPoint

 - For adult moderate sedation privileges, please complete the adult training.
 - For pediatric moderate sedation privileges, please complete the pediatric training.
 - For both adult and pediatrics, both tests are required.
- 3) Successfully complete and electronically submit the appropriate test(s)
(passing score = 90%).
- 4) Complete a brief hands-on competency demonstration in airway management*. To schedule an appointment, please contact Shirley Jackson, RN – Department of Education at 663-2582.

Airway Competency Demonstration Overview:

- ✚ Physicians will participate in a moderate (conscious) sedation simulation requiring rescue from an airways compromise.
- ✚ Evaluations take 5-10 minutes
- ✚ All sessions are located in the Clinical Simulation Lab on the 1st floor to the left of Radiology Desk

*** Airway competency is waived for physicians who are ACLS/ATLS/PALS/NRP certified (as documented in Medical Staff Services files and appropriate to patient population) or credentialed in endotracheal intubation.**
